

The Conference, hosted by the Education Bureau of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, aims to facilitate dialogue among stakeholders about the development of the Hong Kong Qualifications Framework (HKQF), following the completion of the two projects:

- 1. Comparability Study of the HKQF and the European Qualifications Framework (EQF) for Lifelong Learning; and
- 2. Development of Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of Credit Accumulation and Transfer (CAT).

The two milestone projects share one common core objective: supporting mobility and progression of learners in their learning pathways and employment opportunities within and outside Hong Kong. The Conference will provide a forum for participants to explore how the objective could be achieved through collaboration between the education and the business sectors.

The Conference will include panel discussions, parallel sessions, and a marketplace exhibiting CAT information. The Secretary for Education will officiate at the Conference while prominent academics and business leaders will speak on specific topics of HKQF development, implementation and collaboration.
